

GRANTS

2017

- \$9,030 for wildland equipment
- Staffing Adequate Fire & Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant 4-year grant ends 12/2023
\$422,400
 - Paid for 2/3 of day time Lieutenant position to be used as recruitment and retention coordinator
 - Volunteer recruitment marketing materials
 - Turnouts for newly recruited volunteers

2018

- \$315,398 for air packs Joint with Hamlet Fire District
- \$10,000 for security cameras

2019

- \$47,600 for new hose and nozzles

2020

- \$843,124 for new radios Joint with Warrenton, Seaside, Gearhart, Elsie, & Hamlet
- \$46,380 for new supply hose

2021

- High Axle Rescue Vehicle that will be used to replace the 1993 brush truck
- \$10,000 outdoor lighting

Submitted 2021 grants pending approval

- \$525,000 Urban Interface engine
- \$162,000 Breathing air fill station, Exhaust removal system, SCBA fit tester
- \$2.3 Million SAFER 3-year grant for firefighters and fire marshal
- 2.5 million for seismic upgrades to station
- 2 million 4-year SAFER grant joint with Hamlet and Gearhart to focus on marketing and other volunteer programs

Volunteer Association

2018

- \$30,000 in vehicle extrication equipment

2019

- \$32,000 Hear monitor

2020

- \$32,000 for 2 LUCUS (Mechanical CPR device)
- \$8500 in rope rescue equipment

2021

- Over \$20,000 in rope rescue equipment

So far in 2022

- \$15,000 given to district from a donation for Surf Rescue equipment
- \$50,000 (\$30,000 from a donation) for a fire/rescue UTV

Partnerships

- City of Cannon Beach
 - Gives district \$6,000 a year to maintain hydrants, this allows district to hire a part time person to do this and helps with daytime staffing
 - Use of wash rack at public works to help keep vehicles cleaned off after use on beach
 - Joint Emergency management and EOC
 - Joint in Ham radio
 - Joint with Prepared Food Tax
 - Working to as joint with COWS
 - Use of trailer to haul equipment as needed
 - Use of facilities for training
- Greenwood Resources
 - Have permit to do training on their property
- State Parks
 - Contract for services has expired, however still responding and billing for services
 - Join with State Parks for fireworks enforcement over 4th of July
- Very robust Auto/mutual aid program
 - Fire automatic aid
 - Surf rescue joint training and response with Nehalem, Seaside, and Gearhart
 - Rope rescue joint training and response with Nehalem and Seaside
- Volunteer Firefighters Association
 - Ongoing relationship to assist with fundraising
 - Constant communication of District goals that they can assist with funding
- Arch Cape Water & Sanitary
 - Assist with maintaining and testing hydrants
 - They assisted with upgrading AV equipment at Arch Cape station
 -
